We had a fun learning session while sorting an assortment of seashells on Wednesday. We found examples of echinoderms, mollusks, bi-valves, and coral. The children have really taken to an art activity called "Picture Pie". So we are using it as an additional choice activity in the afternoons. Colorful circles are cut into 1/2, 1/4, or 1/8 by folding and cutting, then glued onto a paper in various configurations to make animal pictures.
